## Stretch out and Move Subtitle-Mission Possible, (Excerpt) Pastor Ronald Shaw

### Jeremiah 1:4-10 12:1-3, 6-7, 10-12 Exodus 14:15

Have you ever found yourself in a desperate situation? Perhaps you've found yourself surrounded by people that didn't mean you any good; you're overwhelmed with financial stress and strain. Have you gotten to a point in life where it seems as if the enemy has kept you from the destiny that God has ordained for you? Have you gotten to the point where you're just about ready to give up...?

Our text here shows us that this is the situation with Israel... for they are indeed caught up in a desperate situation... They're caught... Between a rock and a hard place...! I have discovered in this life that just as it was with the Israelites in times past, that many of us have been enslaved and engulfed by the enemy. Our "Modern Day Pharaoh" has literally withdrawn us from our destiny and has taken us out of position to move and operate according to the plan that God has destined for our lives. And because of our bondage, we're stuck standing at the Red Sea of decision (Problem) you're just standing there doing nothing... You're can't turn around because if you do, Pharaoh (your past) will overtake you. You're scared to go forward because before you lies the Red Sea (your destiny) and reaching for your destiny requires you take a risk. But if you're going to move from the banks of the sea to the Land of Promise, if you're going to move from desperation to destiny, it's going to take some effort on your part. There are going to be some prerequisites that must be met. If you're going to reach your destiny, if you plan to move from desperation to destiny, you've got to:

- I. LET GO OF THE PAST
- II. LOOK TO YOUR FAITH
- III. LAUNCH FORWARD!

If you want reach your destiny... If you want to attain and achieve all that God has for you, you've got to launch forward: Into Kingdom Principles, Kingdom Building, and Kingdom Business. For just as Jesus told the disciples in Luke 5:4 to "Launch out into the deep and lay down your nets for a catch...", I hear the Lord telling us we've got to launch out into the sea of life And lay down our nets.... Lay down your mindset... Lay down your way of thinking... Lay down your attitude and perception of things... And receive your catch... Receive your deliverance from the hand of Pharaoh... And receive your Destiny...

You've got to launch forward. We've got to learn how to go forward in the things of God. If you really want to go forward, you've got to learn how to move at His command. Just launch forward no matter what comes your way. It's not that God doesn't want to move, but He's waiting for you to move in Faith!

## Marriage is Important, (Excerpt) First Lady Danyell Shaw Ephesians 5:25, Matthew 19:4-6

How important is marriage? Marriage is an institution that God has established. It is the second relationship established in the book of Genesis. ## Easter (Resurrection Sunday) is April 24

### *The Real Meaning of Easter*

Many people are wondering what Easter actually means, as the true meaning of Easter has been lost. What I can tell you is it isn't about cute little fluffy chickens, nor does it have anything to do with Easter bunnies.

In Old Testament times, the priest would bring bulls, goats or a spotless lamb without any blemishes to be sacrificed as a sin offering for himself and for the people. The blood would purify and make atonement (forgive, make amends) for their sins. This was the old order of atonement. When Jesus came, He was a representation of the sacrificial lamb to take away the sins of the world. He was the final sacrifice. We no longer have to sacrifice animals to make atonement for our sins. Jesus has done this once and for all. It's His blood that cleanses us from all sin. He was crucified on the cross. The sin of the world was upon Him, yet He was without sin and blameless. He bore it all. This is why Jesus is referred to as the 'Lamb of God'. Jesus had to die on the cross and shed His blood for us, so we could be brought back into relationship with God. It was through Jesus blood being shed that our sins have been forgiven (washed away). He was bodily resurrected (came back to life) on the third day. Then, through His resurrection (coming back to life), we too can be risen to new life in Him. When we come to the Lord, He makes us new creations. Let us not forget the real meaning of Easter.
